SAVOY, Illinois – The Village of Savoy takes the circumstances surrounding COVID-19 very seriously and is concerned for the welfare of its citizens and employees. As a result several village services will be reduced or postponed until further notice.

The Savoy Rec Center is closed until further notice. Public access to the Savoy Fire Department will not be allowed, however, fire department staff will continue to serve during emergency situations. Please continue to contact 911 for emergencies. Village meetings and events may be canceled or postponed. Savoy has not received any information regarding the canceling or postponing of the election.
