Champaign County has provided a revised intergovernmental agreement for their animal impoundment services. The revised document is attached. The changes would go into effect beginning July 1, 2020. Fees for animal control are paid annually.

**AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
FOR ANIMAL IMPOUNDMENT SERVICES
(Village of Savoy – County of Champaign)**

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered by and between the Village of Savoy, an Illinois Municipal Corporation, (hereinafter referred to as “Village”) and the County of Champaign, (hereinafter referred to as “County”).

WHEREAS, Section 10 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 and the Illinois Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/1 et seq. enables the parties to enter into agreements among themselves and provide authority for intergovernmental cooperation; and

WHEREAS, the County proposes to provide an Animal Service Facility primarily for the impounding of animals for the use of local law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement is in the best interests of the Village and the County.

Also, for the purposes of this agreement, veterinary services shall be defined as rabies inoculations, health evaluations, the treatment of minor curable diseases and injuries, and euthanasia. Also, for the purposes of this agreement the term animal(s) shall be defined as dogs, cats, rabbits, small rodents, ferrets, and small reptiles. The term animal(s) does not include livestock, exotic animals, or any animal considered to be a “dangerous animal” under the Illinois Dangerous Animals Act, 720 ILCS 585/0.1 et seq., or any other federal or state law or regulation.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. **County to Provide Facilities and Services.** The County shall maintain and operate an animal services facility for the impoundment of animals that are seized by the Village pursuant to Village Ordinances. The County shall provide all services necessary for the impoundment, care, transfer, and euthanasia of all animals delivered by the Village or citizens residing within the Village limits of Savoy. The County will be solely responsible for the hiring and payment of facility

personnel and veterinary services provided by the County Veterinarian at the Animal Services Facility. If outside vet care is needed the County shall inform the City and a joint decision for care will be made. The County is required to provide the services and other obligations in this agreement starting on the date its animal services facility opens or the date this agreement becomes effective, whichever date is later.

2. **Compliance with Laws; Inspections.** The County shall operate the facility in a humane and sanitary manner and in compliance with all applicable state and local laws, ordinances and regulations. The Chief of Police or his designee shall be entitled to inspect and examine the premises and to examine the records kept of impounded animals received from the Village to ensure compliance with this Agreement during normal business hours. Nothing contained herein shall make the Village responsible for the manner of operation or maintenance of the facilities.
3. **Hours of Operation; Access.** The facility shall be open to the public no less than 8 hours per day, Monday through Friday, excluding County holidays. The County shall set the exact hours of service. Village personnel shall have access to the facilities for the purpose of delivering impounded animals at all times. The County shall provide necessary keys, access cards and/or codes to the Village for such purposes. The Village shall be responsible for securing animals delivered and securing the facilities upon departure in the event no County staff is available.
4. **Equipment.** The County shall provide adequate facilities to house the animals delivered to it in a safe and sanitary manner. The County shall endeavor to maintain a minimum of one run or cage for the proper housing and exercise of animals. The County shall maintain separate cages for animals of different species. The County shall have sufficient space to house the normal and customary number of animals that the Village generally needs held for animal control purposes. The Village must give advance notice to the County's Animal Control Director of any extraordinary event that would result in an impoundment of more than three animals, such as the arrest of an animal hoarder. The County will attempt to provide housing in such an extraordinary event but is

unable to guarantee that housing will be provided to all animals in such a circumstance. If the County is unable to provide housing in such an extraordinary event, then the Village must find housing for any animals for which the County is unable to provide housing at the Village's expense. The County will notify the Village as soon as possible in the event it does not have the capacity to house and maintain animals pursuant to this Agreement.

5. **Notice of Delivery and Special Directions.** The Village shall notify the County as soon as practical of its intent to deliver animals to the facility for impound. The Village shall provide information concerning the nature of the impoundment and indicate any special directions it believes may be necessary for the proper handling, care and treatment of the animals. The County shall keep animals impounded for bite quarantine or that are infected with a contagious disease in isolation from all other animals as required by law or in the exercise of sound veterinary practices.

6. **Hold Orders; Orders of Destruction.** In the event a hold order is issued by the Village or a court of competent jurisdiction, the County shall hold the animal and shall not make it available for redemption, adoption or euthanasia without written consent of the Village or Court issuing the hold order. Boarding fees for animals held by the City past the 5, 7 or 10 redemption period as described in the Section 8 of this agreement, shall be paid by the City for each animal held by the Village, for each day or part of a day of impoundment. The daily boarding fee shall be the County boarding fee of \$15.00 per day or any part of a day. The County shall invoice the City on the first of each month, to be paid by the 30th of each month until said animals have been release by a court of law or the city's Legal Department. In the event an Order of Destruction is issued, the County shall humanely euthanize the subject animal(s) pursuant to the Order.

7. **Transfer of Ownership.** Animals delivered to the facility shall become the property of the County after one of the following events occurs: after the expiration of any applicable

redemption period; upon execution of an owner-relinquishment form of the animal's owner(s); after issuance of an order or other release authorizing the County to take ownership of the animal. The County is thereafter authorized to sell, adopt out, convey, euthanize or otherwise dispose of the animal in whatever manner it deems appropriate. The County accepts sole responsibility for its discretionary decision.

8. **Fees.** The County is authorized to collect such fees and fines as authorized by the Champaign County Board and is authorized to collect fees and fines as stated in the Village's Code. All fines and fees collected on behalf of the Village shall be remitted monthly, to be received no later than the 15th day of each month.

9. **Payment.** The Village shall pay an annual rate of \$0.88 per capita for animal impoundment services. The annual rate increase to go into effect on the anniversary date of the signing of this Agreement for each subsequent year of the Agreement will be an adjustment to the previous year's rate by the annual Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (hereinafter "PTELL") CPI rate as set by the State of Illinois in January. Should the PTELL CPI rate be under zero the rate increase shall be 0%; should the PTELL CPI rate be over 5% the rate of increase shall be capped at 5%. In January, the Department shall annually issue to the Village the PTELL CPI rate adjustment for the ensuing contract renewal year. The Village shall pay the County through the Department monthly on the 15th day of each month.

10. **Records.** The County shall keep and maintain all required records in compliance with the Ordinances of the Village and the Statutes of the State of Illinois, which shall include but not be limited to complete financial records covering fees, fines and other charges as well as records of the type and number of animals impounded. The County shall

provide a monthly report of the number of animals received and the final dispositions of the animals. The Village shall provide information concerning the status of pending cases upon request.

11. **Computer Records.** The parties shall endeavor to design/evaluate, procure, implement and maintain a computer records management program. Necessary data shall include: the number of animals housed and/or received on behalf of the Village of Savoy, boarding dates, date of final disposition, type of disposition and any fees associated therewith. Such pertinent data shall be made part of the basis in determining costs associated with the impoundment services provided by the County.

12. **Indemnification.** The Village and the County agree to hold the other party harmless and indemnify the other for any loss, liability or damages arising from any action, omission, or negligence of each party's employees, officers, or agents regarding the performance of this Agreement.

13. **Duration; Termination.** This agreement shall be effective on July 1, 2020 and shall be effective until, either party terminates this contract by notifying the other party in writing at least ninety (90) days before termination is to become effective. 13. **Amendments.** This Agreement may be amended only by writing signed by both parties.

14. **Survival of Provisions.** Any terms of this Agreement that by their nature extend after the end of the Agreement, whether by way of expiration or termination, will remain in effect until fulfilled.



RE: Approval engineering design for Magnolia Court drainage improvements

Attached to this memo you will find a proposal to provide engineering design services and construction observation for the Magnolia Court drainage improvement plan that was included in the recently passed operating budget. Staff has chosen Fehr-Graham to provide these services. Roland White will continue to serve as lead engineer for the project.

Improvements to Magnolia Court will include installation of storm sewer tile from Lot 216 into the Arbours detention basin. A portion of sidewalk that originally served as the overflow for stormwater from the street will also be reconstructed with the addition of a french drain to reduce the amount of water that collects along the walk.

Plans and specifications for the project are anticipated to be completed by August 1, 2020. At that time, staff will discuss with the Board the timing of construction, taking into account effects on our revenues from COVID 19. At the latest, staff expects to complete the improvements before the end of the 2020-21 fiscal year.

Staff recommendation is to approve Fehr Graham to provide engineering design for the Magnolia Court drainage improvements at a cost of \$19,170. This amount was accounted for in our recently approved operating budget.

Dear Mr. Kopmann,

Per our recent discussion, the Village desires to construct a sump pump discharge with focus on Lot 216 on Magnolia Ct. You requested I prepare a proposal to provide design and construction observation services for this effort. A previous feasibility report was prepared for the Village. An exhibit from that report is shown as attachment A to this proposal. The routing of the proposed sump pump tile is along the south side of Magnolia Ct with a service connection to be provided to Lot 216 (No. 3 Magnolia Ct) with an outlet into the nearby detention basin west of the westerly terminus of Magnolia Ct.

The report recommended that vertical location of the sanitary sewer services and any other utility conflicts along the path of the proposed sump pump drainage tile outlet. The potholing services required to do this work are not part of this proposal. The least destructive method that we know of to accomplish this is vacuum excavation. It is recommended that the Village perform the locates or consider engaging a contractor to provide these services. It is possible to include these services in the construction contract, but you risk not knowing the extent of the potential conflicts prior to hiring a contractor to do the full installation.

Scope of Services

The detailed following scope of services are anticipated as part of this effort:

- Additional review of utility information.
- Additional topographic survey to better define the low point at the end of the cul-de-sac and to better define the potential outlet location(s).
- Limited review of tile sizing requirements.
- Preparation of a summary set of design plans including schedule of quantities. Any specifications would be provided as plan notes, with no separate specification package.
- Preparation of an engineer's opinion of probable cost.
- Assistance with bidding questions, shop drawing review etc.
- Construction observation and written summary construction reports during critical installations.

We would anticipate 2 one-hour progress meetings via Zoom with the Village Public Works Director.

Additional Services

Additional services, not described in this proposal, may be requested in writing by the Village.

Fehr Graham will provide an estimated fee for the additional services and obtain written approval from the Village prior to rendering those services.

Schedule

We anticipate a final set of documents as described above to be delivered to the City by August 1, 2020 or sooner.

GENERAL CONDITIONS TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

1. The Client requests the professional services of Fehr Graham hereinafter called "The Consultant" as described herein.
2. The Consultant agrees to furnish and perform the professional service described in this Agreement in accordance with accepted professional standards. Consultant agrees to provide said services in a timely manner, provided, however, that Consultant shall not be responsible for delays in completing said services that cannot reasonably be foreseen on date hereof or for delays which are caused by factors beyond his control or delays resulting from the actions or inaction of any governmental agency. Consultant makes no warranty, expressed or implied, as to his findings, recommendations, plans and specifications or professional advice except that they were made or prepared in accordance with the generally accepted engineering practices.
3. It is agreed that the professional services described in the Agreement shall be performed for Client's account and that Client will be billed monthly for said services. A 1½% per month service charge will be incurred by Client for any payment due herein and not paid within 30 days of such billing which is equal to an ANNUAL PERCENTAGE RATE OF 18%. Partial payments will be first credited to the accrued service charges and then to the principal.
4. The Client and the Consultant each binds himself, his partners, successors, executors, and assigns to the other party to this agreement and to the partners, successor, executors, and assigns of such other party in respect to this agreement.
5. The Client shall be responsible for payment of all costs and expenses incurred by the Consultant for his account, including any such monies that the Consultant may advance for Client's account for purposes consistent with this Agreement.
6. The Consultant reserves the right to withdraw this Agreement if not accepted within 30 days.
7. A claim for lien will be filed within 75 days of the date of an invoice for services (last day of services rendered) unless the account is paid in full or other prior arrangements have been made. All attorney fees incurred by the Consultant due to the filing of said lien or the foreclosure thereof shall be borne by the Client.

In the event suit must be filed by Consultant for the collection of fees for services rendered, Client will pay all reasonable attorney's fees and court costs.

If Client defaults in payment of fees or costs due under the terms of this Agreement and Consultant incurs legal expenses as a result of such failure, Client shall be responsible for payment for Consultant's reasonable attorney fees and costs so incurred.

8. The Consultant shall present, for the consideration of the Client, engineering and technical alternatives, based upon its knowledge and experience in accordance with accepted professional standards, with selection of alternatives and final decisions as requested by the client to be the sole responsibility of the Client.
9. Construction Phase Activities (When applicable) - In connection with observations of the work of the Contractor(s) while it is in progress the Consultant shall make visits to the site at intervals appropriate to the various stages of construction as the Consultant deems necessary in Agreement to observe as an experienced and qualified design professional the progress and quality of the various aspects of the Contractor(s)'s work. Based on information obtained during such visits and on such observation, the Consultant shall endeavor to determine in general if such work is proceeding in accordance with the Contract Documents and the Consultant shall keep the Client informed of the progress of the work.

The purpose of the Consultant's visits to the site will be to enable the Consultant to better carry out the duties and responsibilities assigned to and undertaken by the Consultant during the Construction Phase, and, in addition, by exercise of the Consultant's efforts as an experienced and qualified design professional, to provide for the Client a greater degree of confidence that the completed work of the Contractor(s) will conform generally to the Contract Documents and that the integrity of the design concept as reflected in the Contract Documents has been implemented and preserved by the Contractor(s). The Consultant shall not, during such visits or as a result of such observations of Contractor(s)' work in progress, supervise, direct or have control over Contractor(s)' work nor shall the Consultant have authority over or responsibility for the means, methods, techniques, sequences, or procedures of construction selected by Contractor(s), for safety precautions and programs incident to the work of Contractor(s) or for any failure of Contractor(s) to comply with laws, rules, regulations, ordinances, codes, or orders applicable to Contractor(s) furnishing and performing their work. Accordingly, the Consultant can neither guarantee the performance of the construction contracts by Contractor(s) nor assume responsibility for Contractor(s)' failure to furnish and perform their work in accordance with the Contract Documents.

10. Estimates of Fees - When fees are on a time and material basis the estimated costs required to complete the services to be performed are made on the basis of the Consultant's experience, qualifications, and professional judgment, but are not guaranteed. If the costs appear likely to exceed the estimate in excess of 20%, the Consultant will notify the Client before proceeding. If the Client does not object to the additional costs within seven (7) days of notification, the increased costs shall be deemed approved by the Client.
11. The Consultant is responsible for the safety on site of his own employees. This provision shall not be construed to relieve the Client or the Contractor(s) from their responsibility for maintaining a safe work site. Neither the professional services of the Consultant, nor the presence of his employees or subcontractors shall be construed to imply that the Consultant has any responsibility for any activities on site performed by personnel other than the Consultant's employees or subcontractors.
12. Original survey data, field notes, maps, computations, studies, reports, drawings, specifications and other documents generated by the Consultant are instruments of service and shall remain the property of the Consultant. The Consultant shall provide copies to the Client of all documents specified in the Description of Services.

Any documents generated by the Consultant are for the exclusive use of the Client and any use by third parties or use beyond the intended purpose of the document shall be at the sole risk of the Client. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Client shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Consultant for any loss or damage arising out of the unauthorized use of such documents.

13. No claim may be asserted by either party against the other party unless an action on the claim is commenced within two (2) years after the date of the Consultant's final invoice to the Client.
14. If a Client's Purchase Order form or acknowledgment or similar form is issued to identify the agreement, authorize work, open accounts for invoicing, provide notices, or document change orders, the preprinted terms and condition of said Purchase Order shall be superseded by the terms hereof.
15. Standard of Care - Services performed by Consultant under this agreement will be conducted in a manner consistent with that level of care and skill ordinarily exercised by members of the profession currently practicing under similar conditions. No other representation expressed or implied, and no warranty or guarantee is included or intended in any report, opinion or document under this agreement.
16. Liability Insurance - Consultant will maintain such liability insurance as is appropriate for the professional services rendered as described in this Agreement. Consultant shall provide Certificates of Insurance to Client, upon Client's request, in writing.
17. Indemnification and Limitation of Liability - Client and Consultant each agree to indemnify and hold the other harmless, including their respective officers, employees, agents, members, and representatives, from and against liability for all claims, costs, losses, damages and expense, including reasonable attorney's fees, to the extent such claims, losses, damages or expenses are caused by the indemnifying party's acts, errors or omissions.

The Client understands that for the compensation herein provided Consultant cannot expose itself to liabilities disproportionate to the nature and scope hereunder. Therefore, the Client agrees to limit Consultant's liability to the Client arising from Consultant's professional acts, errors or omissions, such that the total aggregate liability of Consultant shall not exceed \$50,000 or Consultant's total fee for services rendered on this Project, whichever is less.


18. Allocation of Risk - Consultant and Client acknowledge that, prior to the start of this Agreement, Consultant has not generated, handled, stored, treated, transported, disposed of, or in any way whatsoever taken responsibility for any toxic substance or other material found, identified, or as yet unknown at the Project premises. Consultant and Client further acknowledge and understand that the evaluation, management, and other actions involving toxic or hazardous substances that may be undertaken as part of the Services to be performed by Consultant, including subsurface excavation or sampling, entails uncertainty and risk of injury or damage. Consultant and Client further acknowledge and understand that Consultant has not been retained to serve as an insurer of the safety of the Project to the Client, third parties, or the public.

Client acknowledges that the discovery of certain conditions and/or taking of preventative measures relative to these conditions may result in a reduction of the property's value. Accordingly, Client waives any claim against Consultant and agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Consultant and its subcontractors, consultants, agents, officers, directors, and employees from any claim or liability for injury or loss allegedly arising from procedures associated with environmental site assessment (ESA) activities or the discovery of actual or suspected hazardous materials or conditions. Client releases Consultant from any claim for damages resulting from or arising out of any pre-existing environmental conditions at the site where the work is being performed which was not directly or indirectly caused by and did not result from, in whole or in part, any act or omission of Consultant or subcontractor, their representatives, agents, employees, and invitees.

If, while performing the Services set forth in any Scope of Services, pollutants are discovered that pose unanticipated or extraordinary risks, it is hereby agreed that the Scope of Services, schedule, and costs will be reconsidered and that this Agreement shall immediately become subject to renegotiation or termination. Client further agrees that such discovery of unanticipated hazardous risks may require Consultant to take immediate measures to protect health and safety or report such discovery as may be required by law or regulation. Consultant shall promptly notify Client upon discovery of such risks. Client, however, hereby authorizes Consultant to take all measures Consultant believes necessary to protect Consultant and Client personnel and the public. Furthermore, Client agrees to compensate Consultant for any additional costs associated with such measures.

19. In the event of legal action to construe or enforce the provisions of this agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to collect reasonable attorney fees, court costs and related expenses from the losing party and the court having jurisdiction of the dispute shall be authorized to determine the amount of such fees, costs and expenses and enter judgment thereof.
20. Termination - The obligation to provide further services under this Agreement may be terminated by either party upon seven (7) days written notice in the event of substantial failure by the other party to perform in accordance with the terms hereof through no fault of the terminating party. In the event of any termination, Consultant will be paid for all services rendered to the date of receipt of written notice of termination, at Consultant's established chargeout rates, plus for all Reimbursable Expenses including a 15% markup.
21. Provision Severable - The unenforceability or invalidity of any provisions hereof shall not render any other provisions herein contained unenforceable or invalid.
22. Governing Law and Choice of Venue - Client and Consultant agree that this Agreement will be governed by, construed, and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois. If there is a lawsuit, Client and Consultant agree that the dispute shall be submitted to the jurisdiction of the Illinois District Court in and for Stephenson County, Illinois.

Attached to this memo you will find the quote from Area Wide Technologies for the total cost of replacing the fire dept server. Savoy Fire Department currently has contract with Area Wide Technologies for all of our IT needs including Email, Security Certificate, and Firewall.

Currently there are three separate servers that are operating. The main server was manufactured in 2011 and is running on Microsoft Server 2016, the Firehouse Server was manufactured in 2013 and is running on Microsoft Server 2008R2, and the last is the DNS server. The DNS was manufactured around 2001 and was acquired from a member of the department and repurposed. As of 1-14-2020, Microsoft has stopped supporting Microsoft Server 2008R2. This means that they will no longer provide updates or security patches, leaving the Firehouse Server and our entire system more susceptible to viruses and incursion. Aside from operating system issues, the age of the servers leaves them highly susceptible to unrepairable failure. All three servers will be replaced by one server that will be able to do the function of all three. This server will also accommodate the required Computer Aided Dispatch update by METCAD.

The Finance Department intends to provide you with a written "summary" of activities, as it continues to receive input, guidance and recommendations from the Board of Trustees on what its monthly report should "look like/include". As I mentioned, during my report to you on April 22nd, the accounts payable "check register" list is approximately three weeks old by the time the board "approves" the expenditures for the month. Although I have often wondered why it was presented in this manner, I did not feel it was my place to question something that had been in place for some time. Furthermore, it seemed to be an appropriate (and accepted) manner by which you reviewed those items. Trustee members occasionally question certain checks (often based on the amount and invoice description), and we prepare a considerably number of checks on a weekly basis. Unfortunately, I cannot commit to memory each check that is prepared, especially since our software is somewhat antiquated – you may remember that each check's "make-up" has the potential to include several items. Because of this, a larger check (for example, to pay a monthly Village credit card balance) might appear to be only for "office supplies", when a majority of the invoice might be for a "big ticket" item not specified by the description.

Please understand that the last thing I want to do is to create a scenario that is the polar opposite of what has been done in the past. The Finance Department wants to continue an environment of transparency, however too much information has the potential to create a multitude of questions – I may not be able to provide you with adequate explanations in "real time". Our overall objective is to develop a positive dialogue, for better understanding, rather than just regurgitate the checks that we write each month. Until recently, there had not been an openly-expressed desire to track the current "health" of Village finances and I am interested in facilitating those new requests. I hope this makes sense, and I anticipate your input, as we move forward with this new methodology.

As we prepare to implement the new manner of presenting our "financial health", I want to bring a few things to your attention. Please forgive me if you already understand this process – my intention is not to offend anyone by questioning their intelligence. Each

intelligence. Each year when the fiscal year is coming to an end, and we ready ourselves for the annual audit, there are often a number of things that directors/department heads have planned for during the budget year that have not yet been realized. Invoices for these budgeted expenditures finally reach us as April 30th quickly approaches and most-likely will not be paid until May 1st or after. We have the ability to AND will “back-date” these items to April 30th. In addition, we are not able to “foresee” what “General Fund” transfers will need to take place at fiscal year-end as these back-dated expenditures are executed. Two things can then happen – we will either come in under budget (a good thing), or request a “budget amendment” if the expenditure exceeds what was budgeted. There is one final thing for you to keep in mind. The Village really doesn’t receive a clean “bill of health” until the audit is completed and presented to the board.

During this transition, please feel free to ask questions or offer additional input/recommendations. We intend for this exercise to be positive, productive, efficient AND successful!!
