**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2020 LIQUOR LICENSE
TO EXTEND THE RENEWEL DATE TO AUGUST 1, 2020 AND
WAIVE/PRORATE FEES FOR MONTHS ESTABLISHMENTS
ARE CLOSED DUE TO COVID-19 EMERGENCY ORDERED
SHUT DOWN**

WHEREAS, the Village of Savoy, State of Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing Municipality created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto with full powers to enact ordinances for the benefit of the residents of the Village and the Village previously enacted the Revised Code of Ordinances of the Village of Savoy; and

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2020, the World Health Organization declared the outbreak of COVID-19 to be a public health emergency of international concern and on March 11, 2020 declared a worldwide pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, the U.S. Health and Human Services Secretary declared a public health emergency for the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Illinois issued a disaster proclamation on March 9, 2020 due to the impact of the COVID-19 virus and has activated the State Emergency Operations Center; and

WHEREAS, the State Emergency Management Agency has declared a public health emergency due to the impact of the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020 the Governor of the State of Illinois issued Executive order 2020-07 whereby beginning March 18, 2020 all public gatherings of 50 or more people would be prohibited and whereby provisions of the Illinois Open Meetings Act 5 ILCS 120 requiring physical presence at municipal meetings is suspended; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees and President have considered the existence of a public health emergency due to COVID-19 in that it spreads easily, presents a life-threatening illness, strains public health systems, and results in death to such an extent that extraordinary measures must be taken to protect the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees and President have considered that as a result of various emergency orders various businesses have been ordered closed or are highly restricted which has imposed a significant financial burden on them; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Savoy has determined that it is advisable, necessary and in the best interest of the Village and its residents to extend the 2020 liquor license renewal date to August 1, 2020, waive fees (prorated), and reimburse (prorated) fees to those business that have already provided payment to the Village for months establishments are closed due to the COVID-19 emergency ordered shut down for establishments that hold a Class A, B, D and F liquor license.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Savoy, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. Incorporation Clause.

The President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Savoy hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose.

This Ordinance is to amend the 2020 liquor license due date to August 1, 2020 and to waive/prorate/reimburse fees for months establishments are closed due to the COVID-19 emergency ordered shut down which hold Class A, B, D and/or F liquor licenses.

Section 3.

All existing retail liquor licenses shall be valid until August 1, 2020 unless sooner revoked or suspended. Any license fee for 2020 now shall instead be due on August 1, 2020.

The Village of Savoy will waive and prorate or reimburse and prorate such license fees for months establishments are closed due to the COVID-19 emergency order by the Governor of the State of Illinois shutting down such businesses.

Section 4. Superseder and Publication.



Section 5. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval, as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.
